

# State of Affairs in Bangladesh: Forms of Gender Based Violence

# Around 50% of all violence against women happens as a **Domestic Violence** result of dowry culture 27% of married women get raped by their husband Limited opportunities to work at night-shift and weak maternity leave policies **Workplace Violence** Unfavorable business environment for women entrepreneurs Victim Blaming culture against women **Sexual Violence** Lack of implementation of guidelines addressing sexual harassment given by Supreme Court Denial of equal rights increases GBV **Racist Violence** Prevalence of violence against minority population such

as transgenders
