# Challenges/ Limitations- Why the Existing Mechanisms Do Not Work

- Supply Side
  - Structural Problems
    - Reactive rather than proactive- no effort to facilitate or amplify marginalized voices
    - Legal barriers for CSOs
  - Issues Related with Voice
    - Gatekeeping bars selection of representative voices
    - Information has not been disseminated properly & digital divide
  - Reflection and Accountability



#### **Demand Side**

- Concerns about representation
  - Concerns are there whether the CSOs really reflect or represent the LNOBs
  - Local level LNOB groups/ organizations do not get access to policy process
- Problems in coalition building
- Technical Capacity
- Collective Action Problem
- The outcome is the growth of an 'Iron Triangle' where bureaucracy plays the role of gatekeeper to prevent access for the LNOB groups

## Democratic Governance

- Dealing with administrative resistance- how can we identify and develop the 'right' incentive framework?

#### Demand Side

- As coalition building is the key, how can we bring together the rights-based organizations to create pressure?
- How can we make sure that the LNOB groups will be part of the coalition?
- How to create an enabling environment to support the CSOs and LNOB Groups?

### Supply Side

- How can we ensure that the 'right stakeholders' will be chosen?
- How to ensure that LNOB voices are recorded?
- How to ensure accountability?
